After the appellate division sua sponte determined that prior counsel provided ineffective assistance, the Pashman Stein team took on the assignment and the Appellate Division ultimately reversed the decision to terminate the natural parent's parental rights and vacated the order of adoption.

"My clients often face issues with child custody, parenting time, and similar matters," said Tracy. "In this particular matter, a mother's parental rights were terminated. This area of law is a call to service, regardless. When you can see someone through these difficult situations and bring civility, calm and solutions to those problems for them, it's a very rewarding way to practice law."
